作業標準

(113.5.7) 112學年度第7次系所務會議通過

- 一、目的:為獎勵本系具有研究潛力之優秀博士生,支持其安心就學及專心研究,特訂定本 獎學金作業標準。
- 二、依據:本校「國家科學及技術委員會博士生研究獎學金試辦方案」實施要點。
- 三、獎學金核給年限及金額:

(一)每名博士生每月獎學金新臺幣40,000元整。

(二)自博士班一年級起獎勵三年;於三年內畢業者,獎勵至畢業當月止。四、申請對象:

(一)當年度錄取並註冊入學之博士班一年級新生(含二月、九月註冊)。

- (二)不包括香港、澳門及大陸地區學生身分入學者。
- 五、名額:視當年本校核定名額為準,以1名為原則。
- 六、申請時間及程序:

(一)申請時間:以當年度公告為主(大約五月或六月)。

- (二)申請程序:申請人應於申請期限內填具申請表及相關資料,送交本系辦公室。 七、審查項目與程序:
 - (一) 審查項目:
 - 1.碩士班學習表現(如:成績單)。
 - 2.碩士論文或等同碩士論文的專題報告。
 - 3.學術表現(如:碩士論文獲獎、論文發表)。
 - (二)審查程序:由本系辦公室受理申請案件完成資格審查後,邀請本系教師組成「博士生研究獎學金審議小組」負責資料審查,與完成推薦(得從缺)。審查結果提 交本校教務處審定核發。
- 八、續領評估:
 - (一)獲獎生於第一至二年七月三十一日前,向本系提交該學年度之完整報告以申請續 領,經本系博士生研究獎學金審議小組審核通過,送教務處申請下一學年度續領 本獎學金。
 - (二)獲獎生於第三年(最後一年)七月三十一日前,向本系提交該學年度之完整報告, 以為結案。
- 九、續領標準(符合其一):
 - (一)前一學年學業成績須達GPA4.0以上。
 - (二)前一學年於特殊教育相關學術期刊發表(含被接受)論文至少1篇(含SSCI、 SCIE、TSSCI、THCI或教育學院認可之期刊)(須為第一作者或通訊作者)。

(三) 其他國際學術活動與表現成果優異。

- 十、獎勵成果效益追蹤機制:本系定期追蹤獲獎生畢業後三年內,在學術研究成果表現或在 產業就業貢獻流向等,於每年七月底前主動送交本系,再由本系提交教務處備查,獲獎 生不得拒絕。
- 十一、申領本獎學金者,當學年不得重複請領其他獎學金。
- 十二、獎勵期間有下列情形之一者,取消其受獎資格,自事實發生日次月起終止本獎學金, 且不再恢復,其名額由本系備選名單遞補;若無遞補人選,則名額歸還本校:
 - (一)於公私立機構從事專職全時之有給職工作或以在職生身分報考者。。
 - (二)錄取後辦理休學、保留入學資格或未完成註冊。
 - (三) 逕行修讀博士學位學生轉回(入) 碩士班就讀。
 - (四)已支領同屬政府部門獎學金性質經費者。
 - (五) 未獲本系繼續推薦。
- 十三、獲獎生所繳納之資料,如有偽造、假借、塗改等不實情事,撤銷其獲獎資格,已領取 之獎學金應予繳回,並依情節追究相關責任。
- 十四、本標準如有未盡事宜,依國科會及本校相關規定辦理。
- 十五、本標準經系所務會議通過後實施,修正時亦同。

National Taiwan Normal University Department of Special Education Implementation Standards for the National Science and Technology Council Graduate Research Fellowship Pilot Program

Approved at the Seventh Departmental Affairs Meeting of the 2023 Academic Year on May 7, 2024

- 1 Purpose: These Implementation Standards (hereinafter "the Standards") have been established to reward outstanding doctoral students in this Department who demonstrate strong research potential, and to support their ability to pursue their studies with peace of mind and concentrate fully on research.
- 2 These Standards have been formulated in accordance with the Implementation Guidelines of National Taiwan Normal University's (hereinafter "the University") National Science and Technology Council Graduate Research Fellowship Pilot Program.
- 3 Fellowship duration and amount:
 - (1) Each doctoral student shall receive a monthly fellowship of NT\$40,000.
 - (2) The fellowship shall be awarded for a period of 3 years, beginning from the first year of doctoral study. For students who graduate within 3 years, the fellowship shall be granted up to the month of graduation.
- 4 Eligibility:
 - (1) First-year doctoral students who have been admitted and have registered in the current academic year, including those enrolled in February or September, are eligible.
 - (2) Students admitted under Hong Kong, Macau, or Mainland China citizenship are not eligible.
- 5 Quota: The number of recipients shall be determined on the basis of University's approved quota for the given year, with a general principle of selecting one recipient.
- 6 Application period and procedure:
 - (1) Application period: Subject to the official announcement for the given year (typically in May or June).
 - (2) Application procedure: Applicants must complete the application form and submit the required documents to the departmental office within the designated application period.
- 7 Review criteria and procedure:
 - (1) Review criteria:
 - 1. Academic performance during the master's program (e.g., transcripts)
 - 2. Master's thesis or an equivalent research project report
 - 3. Academic achievements (e.g., awards received for the master's thesis, publication of papers)
 - (2) Review procedure: Upon completion of an eligibility verification by the departmental office, a Graduate Research Fellowship Review Committee composed of faculty members from the

Department shall be convened to review the submitted materials and make a recommendation (such recommendation may be withheld if no suitable candidate is found). The results of the review shall be submitted to the University's Office of Academic Affairs for disposition and fellowship disbursement.

8 Renewal evaluation:

- (1) Recipients must submit a comprehensive report for the current academic year to the Department by July 31 of their first or second year to apply for fellowship renewal. Upon review and approval by the Graduate Research Fellowship Review Committee, the application will be forwarded to the Office of Academic Affairs to be renewed for the next academic year.
- (2) Recipients in their third year (the final year of eligibility) must submit a comprehensive report for the current academic year to the Department by July 31 as a requirement to conclude the program.
- 9 Renewal criteria (at least one of the following must be met):
 - (1) The applicant's academic performance in the previous academic year must meet a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 4.0.
 - (2) The applicant must have published (or have accepted for publication) at least one paper in a scholarly journal related to special education during the previous academic year. Eligible journals are those indexed by SSCI, SCIE, TSSCI, or THCI, or other journals recognized by the College of Education. The applicant must be listed as the first author or corresponding author.
 - (3) The applicant must have demonstrated outstanding achievements in other international academic activities or scholarship.
- 10 Mechanism for tracking fellowship outcomes: The Department shall regularly track the academic research achievements and career development of fellowship recipients for a period of 3 years after graduation. Recipients are required to submit relevant information to the Department by the end of July each year, which the Department will forward to the Office of Academic Affairs for record-keeping. Recipients must comply with this reporting requirement.
- 11 Recipients of this fellowship may not concurrently receive any other fellowship or scholarship during the same academic year.
- 12 This fellowship shall be terminated without reinstatement if any of the following conditions is met during the award period. Termination shall take effect from the month following the occurrence of the disqualifying event. The vacant slot shall be filled by a candidate from the Department's alternate list; if no such candidate is available, the remaining funds shall be returned to the University. The conditions for termination of the fellowship are as follows:
 - (1) The recipient is employed in a full-time paid position at a public or private institution or is

admitted as an in-service student.

- (2) The recipient defers their studies, retains their student status, or fails to complete registration after admission.
- (3) The recipient is a student directly admitted to the doctoral program who transfers to or enrolls in a master's program.
- (4) The recipient receives funding from another government-sponsored scholarship program of a similar nature.
- (5) The recipient does not receive continued endorsement from the Department.
- 13 If any submitted materials are found to be falsified, misrepresented, or altered, the recipient's fellowship eligibility shall be revoked, any disbursed fellowship funds must be repaid, and all relevant penalties shall be enforced in accordance with the severity of the case.
- 14 Any matters not covered in these Standards shall be handled in accordance with the relevant regulations of the National Science and Technology Council and the University.
- 15 These Standards shall be implemented pending approval in a Departmental Affairs Meeting, as shall any subsequent amendments.
